



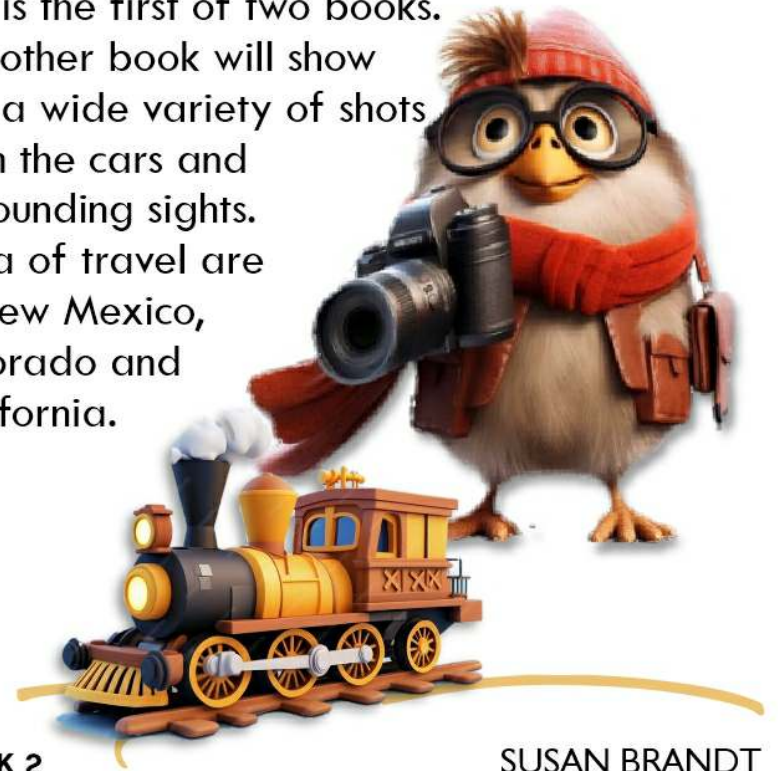

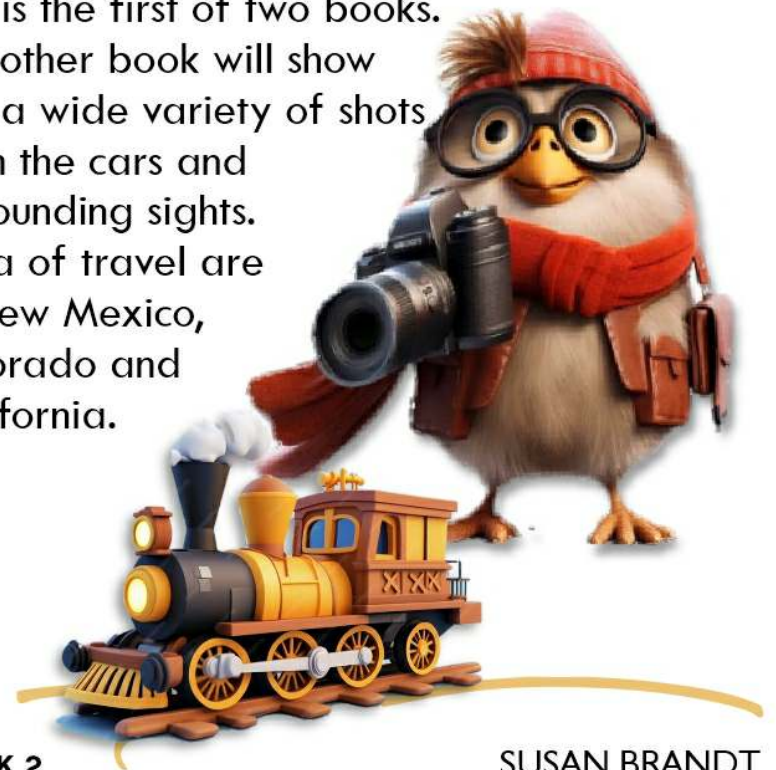

WORLD'S LARGEST, SUCCESSFUL STEAM LOCOMOTIVE

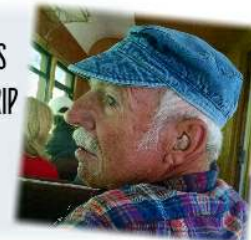
THIS MONSTROUS BLACK TRAIN... 4005 ... IS KNOWN AS “BIG BOY” BECAUSE OF ITS IMMENSE SIZE AND POWER. BUILT IN 1941, BY THE AMERICAN LOCOMOTIVE CO. AT A COST OF \$285,000 WITH A TOTAL WEIGHT OF OVER 600 TONS. “BIG BOYS” ARE 132' 9 1/4" LONG, CARRIES 33 TONS OF COAL AND 25,000 GALLONS OF WATER IN ITS TENDER. THERE ARE EIGHT OF THE ORIGINAL 25 BIG BOYS IN OPERATION CURRENTLY. IT IS A 4-8-8-4 (SIMPLE) ARTICULATED LOCOMOTIVE. THIS 4005 SHOWN HERE IS ON EXHIBIT IN DENVER, COLORADO AT THE FORNEY MUSEUM OF TRANSPORTATION.
